Dear Resident Families,

We pray that this letter finds you healthy and well! We are happy to announce that we continue to be Covid-19 Free here at the Mullen Home. Your loved one's vital signs, including temperatures and respiratory system tracking is done daily here at the Home. Everyone has passed the test with flying colors and we are grateful for that!

The main update that we have for you is the way we are providing the visits for the families. We are still under the Public Health Order for the City and County of Denver which states that we cannot allow on-site visits from non-essential visitors. However, we have figured out a way to have you visit your family thru the fence that surrounds the property. The best location for doing this is on 30th Avenue, which is on the North side of the building. We are able to take your loved one to the back of the building along the East side. We just need for you to communicate with us via phone call to let us know that you are there waiting to visit with your family member. We will provide the Residents with masks, so we would be grateful for you to wear your mask as well. It is also crucial to follow the mandate of 6-foot distancing (even thru the fence/gate). We are able to leave the Resident to visit privately with you, except in the case of someone who may need to be monitored for safety. Please contact the Home if you would like to arrange a visit with your loved one at 303-433-7221. Ask for either Sr. Caroline (2nd floor) or Sr. Mary William (1st floor).

Meanwhile, we have been informed by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment that we will not be mandated to test all Residents and staff at the Home at this time. It is being highly recommended but we have been told that we will most likely be one of the last Homes to be contacted regarding testing due to the fact that we are one of the smaller facilities in the State. We will keep you informed on this recommendation in the coming weeks.

Thank you again for your prayers and patience during this challenging time. We know that God is with all of us, keeping us close to Him.
