Dear Resident Families,

We have made it another week since our last letter and we are happy to report that we continue to have no cases of the Covid-19 at Mullen Home! Our Residents and staff have all been very healthy and very compliant with the latest requirements by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment:

1. All Residents are required to wear cloth masks when outside of their room and when other people enter their room. They are advised by the Health Department to at least cover their mouth with a tissue or cloth when a staff person enters their room.
2. No visitation from non-essential visitors at this time.

We are waiting to hear from the Health Department in the next couple of weeks as to whether it will be mandated to test all Residents and staff at the Home for Covid-19. We receive all of our directives from the Denver Department of Public Health and Environment and Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, both of which work directly with the Centers of Disease Control and Centers for Medicaid and Medicare Services.
