The symptoms of this person have been very mild. They were advised to take the COVID-19 test and it came back positive today. They have been quarantined since Monday 8/3/20. We are in communication with this person regarding any updates or changes in condition.

Meanwhile, we want all of you to know that we take all of the Residents' and staff's health and wellbeing very seriously. We are working to protect the Home from COVID-19 to the greatest extent possible. The following steps are being taken to keep everyone safe:

1. All Residents and staff are being strongly encouraged to wear their masks throughout the Home.
2. All nursing home Residents will now be monitored with temperature and changes in respiratory system twice a day.
3. All family visits will be put on hold until further notice.

We thank all of you for your continued support, including your spiritual support of prayers. We are grateful for everyone being so understanding during this pandemic. We know that we can get thru these difficult times by staying positive and communicative.
