Dear Resident Family and Friends,

We continue to have no cases of COVID-19 here at Mullen Home and we are very blessed! Thank you for continuing to adhere to the guidelines that we have put forth over the past few months. We are hoping to move towards Indoor Visitation based on recent guidelines put forth by Governor Polis. We have been meeting daily to discuss how we can move forward with these visits here at Mullen Home. However, due to the fact that all visitors will be required to test negative within 48 hours of each visit, we are still attempting to figure out how to move forward with the indoor visits. We will keep you posted over the next week on how we can move in that direction.

Meanwhile, we will continue to have our Outdoor Visitation and I would like to point out a few reminders to you at this time regarding Outdoor Visits:

1. Please make sure to call the receptionist as soon as you arrive on the property. The receptionist may ask you to wait in your vehicle until the monitor is ready to meet you in the designated visiting area.
2. The designated visiting area is currently outside of the Activity Room until further notice. The location of the visits may change at times due to the weather, the Resident's condition or even if there are not enough monitors at the time of the scheduled visit.
3. We have opened the visits up to children now; however, no pets are allowed for visits at this time.
4. All food brought for your family member should first be brought to the receptionist prior to given to your loved one at the visit so as to ensure everyone's safety.
5. The visits are scheduled through Monica, the Volunteer Coordinator, at this time by calling the main number at 303-433-7221.

Thank you in advance for continuing to respect and adhere to the visiting regulations, including screening, wearing face coverings, social distancing and hand hygiene!
