Dear Families and Friends of our Mullen Home Residents,

As we begin a new week, I wanted to report to you that our second Coronavirus vaccination clinic went extremely well this past Tuesday, so most of our Residents and staff are now vaccinated and hopefully building up immunity.

We have resumed COVID testing with the State lab and our Jan. 28 house-wide testing results were all negative. Praise God!

Thank goodness the Coronavirus testing positivity rate in both Denver County and Denver Metro have remained below 5% for a second straight week (amazing, in view of what's going on in so many other areas!). So assuming that it stays down and that we do not get new positive test results among our Residents, we are tentatively hoping to expand compassionate care in-room visiting once again possibly starting February 9th, which will be the two-week date by which most of us at the Home will have developed post-vaccination immunity. In the meantime, window visits continue to be available.

So that's it for now. We thank God for His blessings, and we wish you all a wonderful week!
